DAILY SAFETY CHECKLIST FOR EDUCATORS

Safety checks are to be completed daily. There are many procedures and processes in place within a service to prevent illness and accidents. The commitment to the prevention of incidents and accidents occurring within the service is paramount and entails ensuring staff and management take all precautions and measures to create a safety conscious culture. One contributing step is to complete a safety check every day. Providing a safe environment, and protecting children in your care facilitates a child to explore their world and develop trust.



Good practice is to store the completed documents within a Health and Safety folder, using separate tabs folder marked for each individual category. Categories such as safety check, risk assessments, first aid records, maintenance, emergency drills, etc should all be located in this folder.

These safety checks can provide documentational evidence as additional verification for the completion of a service safety audit.
